# Recognizing Joel Kaplan's Community Service

Humble words were spoken by Joel Kaplan as he walked into a surprise reception, held at Liberty's Day Support Café, to honor his lifetime commitment to the Amsterdam community, as well as to Liberty.

Joel, a longtime Liberty board member, was honored by Liberty, his family, friends and peers for his many years of service. At the reception, Joel was presented with a key to the city, proclamations from both Congressman Paul Tonko and Assemblyman Angelo Santabarbara and a special tribute song sung by Liberty advisor Valerie Beekman. He was also recognized by NYSARC executive director Marc Brandt, Liberty CEO Jennifer Saunders, former Liberty CEO Frank Capone, and longtime friend and Liberty board member Bob Purtell.

The Missoula Children's Theatre is a traveling ensemble aimed at fostering creativity and enhancing acting capabilities in individuals all over the world by providing access to community-driven performing arts experiences. They hope to aid in the development of life skills in children through participation in the performing arts, through education, entertainment, and enrichment in the performing arts.

Two public performances were given by the children in the FSS recreation program after participating in a week-long residency with two professional actors. All props and costumes were provided for this full-length production.

The play was a great success; with the children enjoying this new adventure and their family and friends watching them perform on the "big" stage!

This opportunity by made possible through a grant by NYSARC, Liberty's parent agency. The Trustees of the NYSARC Trusts provided Liberty with a \$10,000 grant to support recreational opportunities individuals in program. The

NYSARC Trusts administer supplemental needs trusts that enable people who have disabilities to remain in their home and community and retain their Medicaid eligible services. The Trustees utilize remainder funds to benefit other persons with disabilities including unfunded Chapter guardianship programs as provided by statute. In addition to the recreation grant, the Trustees awarded \$1,225,500 to support Chapter Guardianship programs throughout the state. control number and whether there is or ever was a lien and a copy of the lien release. (All vehicles must have a clean title.) By Telephone: Call The Arc toll free line at (1-877-272-2270). Be sure to have all information ready. After your vehicle has been picked up, you will receive a formal receipt from The Arc. Arrangements for your vehicle to be placed in a local auction will be made by Melwood. You will receive a letter, along with the IRS 1098C form, indicating the amount for which your donated vehicle was sold. (Your tax deduction is based on the sale price.)

## **New Planting Dedication in Honor of Robert Murray**



n a blustery October day, a beautiful Frasier Fir tree was planted and dedicated in remembrance of Robert Murray, a.k.a. Santa, who passed away in March, 2014.


### **OFA Award**
