New Dimensions in Health Care Receives Community Foundation Grant

Grant to Assist in Purchasing Ergonomic Exam Tables

AMSTERDAM- New Dimensions in Health Care (NDHC) has been awarded a \$5,034 grant from the Marjorie Rockwell Fund for the Disabled of The Community Foundation for the Greater Capital Region. Funds from The Community Foundation's Grant will be used to purchase two bariatric exam tables. These exam tables will offer advanced safety and comfort to both patient and staff, allowing NDHC to better serve individuals of all ages, physical impairments, and body types.

The bariatric exam tables allow for height adjustment which improves safety of transfers and ergonomics for staff and patients. These tables also provide increased safety for infant/pediatric exams as the table is extra wide. Funding from the Marjorie Rockwell Fund for the Disabled of The Community Foundation for the Greater Capital Region supports NDHC's commitment to provide equal, high-quality care to the diverse population served at the health center.

New Dimensions Health Care, Inc. (NDHC) operates a Department of Health Licensed Article 28 Diagnostic and Treatment Center in Amsterdam, New York. Currently, NDHC provides the following services to approximately 6,800 patients in the surrounding community: Primary Care, General Dentistry/Oral Surgery, and Podiatry. Specialty medical services such as Pediatric Neurology, Gynecology and Psychiatry provided by consulting physicians, are available primarily to 860 individuals with disabilities. The health center is a National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) recognized facility.
