The organization recognized The Greater Amsterdam School District as this year's Community Partner. Liberty's Facilities Management staff volunteers received the organization's 2015 Community Commitment Award.

Liberty's Chief Executive Officer, Jennifer Saunders introduced the Community Partner award, explaining that the intent of the annual award is to recognize a company or community organization that has shown outstanding support and commitment to people with disabilities in the agency's programs.
