## New Dimensions in Health Care Receives Stewart's Grant

**Essential Healthcare Equipment to Better Serve the Community** 

**AMSTERDAM**- New Dimensions in Health Care (NDHC) has been awarded a \$1000 grant from Stewart's Holiday Match program. Funds from the Match program will be used for the procurement of essential equipment to provide safe and efficient care to the health center's pediatric patients.

These funds will be used towards the purchase of the following:

- Mechanical pediatric scale- will assist staff in getting immediate and accurate measurements.
- Wall mounted Stadiometer- this device will deliver accurate height measurement of children as
  it is stationed against a wall and has a lock knob, which allows the height result to remain visible
  even if the child moves.
- Retractable measuring tape- will enable staff to take a variety of precise measurements that a standard scale does not provide. The convenience and flexibility of the retractable tape allows staff to take measurements of wounds, circumference, length, and growth patterns, among others.

This vital healthcare equipment will enhance NDHC's ability to continue to provide top quality, reliable care to infants and children.
