SUBJECT: COVID -19

We have been notified that a community member, who resides in Montgomery County, has tested positive for Coronavirus (COVID-19). This individual attends college at FMCC and also works at Liberty's residence on Miami Avenue.

In a situation such as this the local Public Health Department official Sara Borenko takes the lead. The limited number of staff who have been determined to have had substantial direct contact with the community member have already been contacted by a Public Health Department representative. They are being scheduled for testing and will remain quarantined for the next 14 days as a precaution. The individuals that reside at Miami Avenue will also be tested and will remain quarantined to their home for the next 14 days.

Liberty ARC takes great care to ensure the safety and well-being of the people we support, our employees, and the community. We are continuing to work closely with State and County health officials to take every precaution to keep people safe. As new safety measures, such as the recently adopted screening of all visitors, are put into place we will be communicating them to you.

We are carefully monitoring the situation and we will continue to share with you any additional recommendations from our local Public Health Department.
