New Dimensions in Health Care Receives Grant for Lead Poisoning Prevention

Amsterdam –New Dimensions in Health Care (NDHC) has been awarded a \$1,000 grant from the Stewart's Holiday Match 2021-2022 program in order to provide lead testing for children in need.

Funds purchased lead test kits, an analyzer, and a printer for on-site testing. The equipment allow the health center staff to provide on-site services, a more convenient method for families, to identify problems early in children with an early diagnosis, allowing for more effective intervention and treatment for possible lead poisoning.

New York State health care providers are required to test lead levels of children at ages of one and two. Lead poisoning can interfere with brain and nervous system development, posing serious, long-term health issues.
