Scott participated in the after-school program and recreation activities, and we received respite services. Liberty ARC has been a part of Scott's life from the start. Like so many families in the area, we are so grateful to have this wonderful resource in our backyard.

In May 2014, Scott took a major step and moved out of our house and into one of Liberty ARC's homes, as part of the residential program. We were more nervous than he was! He was excited to pick the colors of his room and what his bedding looked like. He had so many choices to make that were completely his own. The staff at Liberty ARC were understanding and reassuring, warmly welcoming Scott into his new home. This offered Scott freedom,

independence, opportunity to grow, and most importantly a group of people that became like family to him. For almost ten years now, Scott has considered Liberty ARC his home.
