## Liberty Foundations Raises Over \$50,000 For People With Disabilities With Country Concert

**Amsterdam** – Liberty Foundation held their 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Denim and Diamonds BBQ & Country Concert presented by Marshall & Sterling Insurance and featuring Skeeter Creek on Friday, October 3 at their Liberty ARC Drive campus in Amsterdam. The fundraising event drew 435 guests, a record-breaking attendance, and raised over \$50,000 to support life-enriching experiences and items for people with disabilities in Montgomery and Schenectady Counties.

For the past nine years, Liberty Foundation's Denim and Diamonds event has funded vital programs, services, improvements to homes, and experiences which are not funded through government programs to the people with intellectual and developmental disabilities supported by Liberty ARC.
